**LOCATION:** Manhasset Bay Yacht Club, Port Washington, New York

**RULES:** The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) (1997-2000) (as modified Jan. 1, 1999) and the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as modified by the prescriptions of the Interclub Technical Regulations, as revised on April 20, 1997, and the Sailing Instructions.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** The Manhasset Bay Yacht Club cordially invites all Interclub, Penguin and Sunfish sailors who are members in good standing of their respective classes. All Past Commodores of the Frostbite Yacht Club are invited to sail in the Past Commodores' Race.

The Past Commodores' Race will be held on Saturday, January 1st at 11:00am.

**ENTRIES:** **Pre-registration is encouraged.** Entry fee is \$30.00 for U.S. Sailing members and 40.00 for non-U.S. Sailing members.

**REGISTRATION:** Registration will be open from **10:00am** to **12:30pm** on Saturday, January 1st, at the Manhasset Bay Yacht Club.

**MEASUREMENT:** It is the responsibility of every competitor to make sure his or her boat, sail, and equipment measure to the IC Technical regulations for the Inter Club Dinghy Class, effective April 20, 1997, or as prescribed by the Measurement Committee. The bow tip weight rule shall not be enforced. **Sails must be stamped by your fleet's measurer.** Measurement equipment will be available on site.

The Measurement Committee reserves the right to measure any boats at random during the regatta. Skipper and crew may be required to weigh in after the completion of sailing.

**BOW NUMBERS, RULES, AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be available during registration hours and may be posted on the internet on the Interclub Dinghy National web site.

Bow numbers are required for each yacht. All Interclub dinghies shall have the same sail number as their bow number. If two yachts have the same "bow/sail" numbers, the yacht whose hull's number which matches that "bow/sail" number shall display that number.) This bow number should be

placed within 1 foot of the bow stem. In addition, the bow number must be of contrasting color to the hull.

Life jackets shall be worn at all times.

**SOCIAL EVENTS:** There will be a *party* on Friday, December 31st with *fireworks on the bay!* Further, there will be a *one time special millenium race at 12:10am* on Saturday January 1<sup>st</sup>, “under the lights,” in order to ensure that the IC frostbiters will be able to say for years to come that they sailed the very first sail boat race of the new millenium.
